

# Mountain View SPECS Monday Night Net Script (Remote) for Shelter in Place

**On 145.270 W6ASH repeater:**

*Listen for the net to start (8 pm).*

*From the main net, "Who will take check-ins for Mountain View?"*

**'Check-ins for Mountain View ARES will be taken on the simplex frequency of 146.535 MHz. (or 147.495 MHz) Mountain View stations go there now, please. This is \_\_\_\_\_ <your callsign>.**

*Switch to 146.535 simplex (or alternate)*

**Is this frequency in use? <pause...> Nothing heard.**

**This is \_\_\_\_\_ <your callsign>, \_\_\_\_\_ <your first name> , taking check-ins for Mountain View ARES/RACES on Monday night, \_\_\_\_\_ <day><month><year>**

**I am operating from home with a remote scribe. When you check in, please give your full call sign slowly and phonetically.**

**I acknowledge those present at this station (myself), or heard on the Main Net:**  
*Record and State calls/names of operators present at your location, or on main net.*

**All Mountain View ARES Assistant Emergency Coordinators present, please check in now.**

*Record calls, and/or note calls/names on Mountain View checklist.*

**I copy: State calls copied (include first names)**

**All stations with suffixes A through F, Alfa through Foxtrot, please check in now.**  
*Record calls, and/or note calls/names on Mountain View checklist.*

**I copy:**

*State calls copied (include first names, if available)*

**Are there any other checkins, Alpha thru Foxtrot?**

*State calls copied (include first names, if available)*

*Call on scribe*

**\_\_\_\_\_ <scribe callsign>, do you have any relays for A through F?**

*Record and acknowledge the relayed calls*

**Are there any other relays for A through F?**

*Record and acknowledge the relayed calls*

*Compare totals with scribe:*

**\_\_\_\_\_ <scribe callsign> , my total for group A thru F is \_\_\_\_\_. What is your total?**

*If totals agree, go on to next group. If not, person with highest counts reads the suffixes only (quickly) of whom they heard and you reconcile any differences.*

*Repeat this process for next group of suffixes. Remember to call the scribe after you are done with each group; then invite additional relays, then check with scribe for totals for the group.*

**G through L, (Golf through Lima), then  
M through S, (Mike through Sierra),  
T through Z, (Tango through Zulu).**

**Last call--All stations with suffixes A through Z, Alfa through Zulu, please check in now.**

\_\_\_\_\_ <Scribe> - do you have any remaining relays?  
*Record and acknowledge the relayed calls*

**Any other relays?**  
*Record and acknowledge the relayed calls  
If no further relays:*

\_\_\_\_\_ <Scribe> - What is your grand total?  
*If different, reconcile differences*

**This concludes Mountain View check-ins. Please stand by while I report to the Main Net. I will turn the net over to our shift supervisor,  
\_\_\_\_\_ <shift supervisor callsign>**

*While Supervisor has the net, switch back to 145.270. Wait for a pause in main net traffic.*

**Net Control, this is Mountain View.**  
*When acknowledged by Net Control, state*  
**Mountain View had a total of figures \_\_\_\_\_ <number> check-ins this evening. Standing by for city totals, This is \_\_\_\_\_ <your callsign>.**

*Wait on Main Net until total is announced, note total, then return to 146.535 (or alternate frequency). If local net is still in session wait for announcer to turn the net back to you, and announce the following:*

**Mountain View had \_\_\_\_ <number> and the main net had \_\_\_\_ <number> check-ins tonight.**

*Also report totals for other cities, packet, and UHF.*

**Is there any other business for the local net? <pause...>**  
**Thank you for making your time and equipment available to the net. This is \_\_\_\_\_ <your callsign>, \_\_\_\_\_ <your name>, returning the frequency to general use.**
